



Your Tax Dollars at Work – 2015

1. 3,849 patrons
2. Winter: Avg. 151 visits/day with a peak count of 223
Summer: Avg. 224 visits/day with a peak count of 320
39,174 total annual visits (up 2,300 from 2014)
3. Staff: 1 full-time director at \$40,400; 4 PT staff at \$12.75 -\$17.50/hr working on average 15 to 25 hours/week; Health insurance for director; medical stipends for staff
4. Open 4 ½ days per week
5. 16,626 items in the local collection, including books, e-books, audio books, e-audio books, movies and magazines/newspapers
6. Access to over 1.4 million books and movies through the cooperative catalog shared with 100+ Colorado libraries; 1,803 books and movies borrowed from other libraries (up by 725 from 2014)
7. 35,468 items circulated
8. 4,345 public internet computer sessions (does not count wifi accesses)
9. 35 children's programs with 1,227 attending (284 more than 2014); 31 young adult programs with 665 attending (261 more than 2014)
 - a. Camp Happiness for ages 0-6
 - b. Preschool and day care early literacy visits
 - c. Elementary field trips and programs; book talks and visits with 5th grade
 - d. Monthly tween/teen events (during the school year)
 - e. Summer reading program for ages 0-18; 124 children and 46 teens registered
10. 83 adult programs with 720 attending
 - a. Events throughout the year like author readings, workshops and community outreach events
 - b. Summer reading program; 92 adults registered
 - c. Three monthly book clubs
 - d. Ask a Nurse
 - e. Writers' groups
