



#### **Circulation Statistics**



2022 was a notable year for WCCLD with the launch of several exciting new partnerships, as well as significant changes in the library. The launch of the DMV2GO program, in partnership with the Sheriff's Department, has been hugely popular with the community as it allows for driver license services without the commute to Pueblo or Cañon City. Our establishment as a participating library in the Dolly Parton Imagination Library has allowed us to distribute free books to over 130 children so far. And finally, with grant funding through ARPA and El Pomar, we were able to upgrade and replace all of our computers and network equipment for both staff and patrons.
