00:00 Germany to Canon to Westcliffe; Came to Canon age 13, 1890, Germany; worked for his uncle, ticket was \$85

2:00 worked at orchard in Lincoln Park for 5 years; then to Westcliffe 1907, farm south of the valley

2:45 Mr. Ray's grocery store, Knuth hardware

3:15 built his own grocery store 1909-1922; dry goods 'til 1944, sold out after World War II; went to CA, insurance business

4:45 married 61 years to Elizabeth M (Erps)

6:00 1,000 people in Silver Cliff; William Jennings Bryant Populist party

7:30 stage coach 1 day from Canon

9:00 German colony, Wulstein, 6-week trip from Chicago, oxen, Indians, Buffalo

10:30 Railroads 1901, wagons, freight horse teams, (Beardsley)

11:45 1910 or 11, big fire, whole block

13:00 building Westcliffe after mining

15:00 Lutheran church 1917, \$18,000

16:30 1896 came to Westcliffe

18:00 nothing until tape ends
