00:00 schools, Jackson Hill murder, at the Wetmore Community Center, Mildred born 1913 in Siloam, CO (Pueblo County), Bud born 1916, from Ireland to Canada, Michigan, Elbert, CO

2:00 homestead at Siloam, dad worked a ranch in Wetmore, sold homestead to Everhart

4:15 graduated 8th grade 1928, schools, teachers

6:45 worked for Cusacks at The Pines, Betts and Everharts

10:45 Wetmore garage

20:00 traded cloth for flour and seed sacks for hospitals

22:00 Jackson Hill half-way house - a murder

24:00 Betts saloon

25:30 Greenwood Hotel

26:30 Babcock Hole, Don K Ranch, sanitarium

29:00 electricity 1940, Siloam Telephone Co.

34:00 WOW (Woodmen of the World) Hall, dances, music, Charlie Akins, Billington Ranch

39:00 end of tape
